INTERNSHIP JOB DESCRIPTION

- Posting to social media, drafting press releases, mass emails, etc.
- Coordinating volunteer teams for voter engagement.
- Interface with Assembly, Senate, Congressional, and State Wide Republican campaigns for office.

Successful past participants in the ECGOP Internship Program have gone on to work as key staffers in Albany, NY, and Washington, DC as well as political campaign managers at the state and federal level.
